NATIONAL RULES FOR TRUMAN LAKE



1. The definition of Ethnic Minority in this case will be anyone that is African American, Hispanic American, Asian American, or Native American. Women are also considered a minority in this case as well as our IFBBA International Anglers!
2. This is a catch and release event. No culling in the weigh in water area!
3. The decision by the IFBBA Tournament committee is and will be final on any tournament issue! (no exceptions)
4. All fish to be weighed in must be a minimum length of 15" or 38.1 centimeters or larger. Black Bass are considered largemouth bass, spotted or Kentucky bass, and smallmouth bass in Missouri's Truman Lake.
5. A (5) five fish limit each day. Big Bass will be the largest bass based on weight, not looks!
6. All anglers will launch at first light each day and you will have until 3:00pm to be at the check in station at Bucksaw Marina. This will be your check in point each day! You have a 10 minute grace period to be at the check in station. Anyone who comes to the checkpoint after 3:10 pm will be disqualified for that day! (No exceptions)
7. Every dead fish brought to the weigh in will cost the angler team 25% of your total weight for that day! KEEP THEM ALIVE!
8. All fishing rods must not be longer than 8' foot or 2.4 meters. Only one rod in the water at a time per angler. No trolling at all.
9. Only artificial lures will be used in this tournament Pork skin is allowed.
10. Complaints must be filed with in 30 minutes after the weigh in with the tournament committee. This must be done in writing. Petty gripes and unfounded criticisms will not be tolerated by anyone.
11. Sportsman like conduct is a must! You can be disqualified from this event if this is not followed.
12. This is a Buddy Team Diversity tournament of the IFBBA. Enjoy yourself while you compete against anglers from all over the world and the USA.
13. Ten places will be paid out. This will be based upon 100 boat teams. The IFBBA reserve the right to change and are adjust the financial purse of this event based upon conditions and or situations out of its control, i.e. how many participants, and weather.
14. No alcohol or narcotics are allowed in boats or may be consumed during tournament hours.
15. All winners will be required to take telecommunication voice stress test to determine that the winners have been honest.
16. Boating safety is a must. All boats are subject to be inspected by the Missouri Water Patrol on Truman Lake. Be correct on the water. Ensure everything is working properly.
17. You may pre-fish everyday beginning Monday May 10, 2010 through Friday May 14, 2010. All participants must be off the water by 5:00pm Central Standard Time on all those days. No guides may not be hired after Sunday May 9, 2010. (No exceptions)
