NATIONAL RULES (LAKE MICCOSUKEE) Florida



1. This event is open to all Black Bass Anglers in the USA and our IFBBA International Black Bass Anglers!
2. This is a catch and release event. No culling in the weigh in water area!
3. The decision by the IFBBA Tournament committee will be final on any tournament issue! (no exceptions)
4. All fish to be weighed in must be a minimum length of 18" or more will be accepted.
5. Black Bass are considered largemouth bass, spotted or Kentucky bass in Lake Miccosukee and it's tributaries.
6. A (5) five fish limit each day. Big Bass will be the largest bass based on weight, not looks!
7. All anglers will launch at first light each day and you will have until 3:00pm to be at the check in station at Lake Miccosukee Reeves Public Ramp. This will be your check in point each day! You have a 10minute grace period to be at the check in station. Anyone who comes to the checkpoint after 3:10 pm will be disqualified for that day! (No exceptions)
8. Every dead fish brought to the weigh in will cost the angler team ½lb of your total weight for that day! KEEP THEM ALIVE!
9. All fishing rods must not be longer than 8' foot or 2.4 meters. Only one rod in the water at a time per angler. No trolling at all.
10. Only artificial lures will be used in this tournament. Pork skin is allowed.
11. Complaints must be filed within 30 minutes after the weigh in with the tournament committee. This must be done in writing. Petty gripes and unfounded criticisms will not be tolerated by anyone.
12. SPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT IS A MUST! You will be disqualified from this event if not followed.
13. This is a Open Buddy Team Tournament of the IFBBA. Enjoy yourself while you compete against anglers from all over the world and the USA.
14. Eighty Percent 80% of the total purse will be paid out in the top three positions plus Big Bass Pot! The IFBBA reserve the right to change and/or adjust the financial purse of this event based upon conditions and/or situations out of its control, (i.e. number of participants, weather,).
15. No alcohol or narcotics are allowed in boats nor may be consumed during tournament hours.
16. All winners will be required to take telecommunication voice stress test or polygraph test to determine that the winners have been honest.
17. **BOATING SAFETY IS A MUST.** All boats are subject to be inspected by the Florida Water Patrol Be correct on the water. Ensure everything is working properly.
18. You may pre-fish everyday and anytime up to Friday March 22, 2019. All participants must be off the water by 4:00pm Eastern Standard Time on all those days. No guides may be hired after Sunday, March 17, 2019. (No exceptions)
19. All entries fees of \$200.00 per team must be by going to www.ifbba.com and paying online. Deadline for entry fees are March 15, 2019! IFBBA Membership per person is \$20.00 annually and must be paid before you can participate.
20. Personal Checks, U.S. Postal Money Orders, and Pay Pal are only accepted. \$50.00 bad check charge will apply!
20. On Friday at the Pre-Tournament Meeting you can pay in CASH but a \$10.00 late will be applied to your team entry!
